The Summit features a **Florida Team Showcase** contestant, the University of Florida at Jacksonville Health "Bug Busters" team. Their project focused on reducing surgical site infections by determining why patients were getting them using six sigma green belt techniques to analyze data. The team determined the cost of poor quality to be over \$4.3 million, plus intangible losses. The root cause of the problem and appropriate solution was determined and rolled out through training staff and educating patients. Results from this project resulted in ZERO infections in six of eight months with the average rate dropping below the goal of 3.1 to 0.3%.
